Instructions for ST100 Adapter

BFX Brake Fluid Exchanger

The ST100 may seem a little intimidating to use on a vehicle. One might attempt to use the BA12 adapter since it might appear to fit - **DO NOT**.

The BA12 adapter is to be used on cast iron reservoirs only and not the newer plastic style. Plastic reservoirs may crack while attempting to seal on the top edge. Also, making a seal on this surface is extremely difficult and usually unsuccessful.





ST100 GM & Chrysler

BA12 Universal

The ST100 has two rubber posts with tapered ends which insert into the intake holes in the bottom of the reservoir. The metal brackets are adjusted so these two posts are vertical and seat in the two intake holes for a good seal. Chains are routed around the base of the master cylinder and tightened.
